

APPLICATION FOR LICENTIATESHIP (LBDS) AFFIX

Licentiate (LBDS) recognition is open to those who have been actively engaged in the delivery of design courses, as distinct from those engaged in commercial practice, for a minimum of three years.

It is recommended that applicants for Licentiate recognition must hold formal design qualifications and have worked in the education sector for a minimum period of three years and be fully conversant with training students and others in display design practice at a college of further education or other educational establishment recognised by the Council of the Society.

Applications must be accompanied by evidence of teaching qualifications, a full c.v. and supported by a relevant portfolio and details (as appropriate) of freelance commissions.

Holders of LBDS recognition are entitled to attend the general meetings of the Society.

After three years, holders of LBDS recognition may formally apply for Fellowship (FBDS) recognition.
